## FALL CLEAN-UP DAYS

**NOVEMBER 4 - 6**

Time to get homes and yards cleaned up before winter sets in. Dumpsters will be at four locations around town:

- 27th Street Rd across from Town Hall
- 7th Avenue, next to the Garden City Park
- 6th Avenue & 26th St. at Knights of Columbus
- 9th Ave. & 27th St. at the Kendrick's Home

This is a free service to residents and businesses in Garden City.



Please be sure to get all your garbage into the dumpsters and keep the area clean. Items that are **not allowed** in the dumpsters include toxic chemicals, paint, oil, appliances containing freon (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc), and batteries. Call the Town Hall at 970-351-0041 for more information on Weld County's Hazardous Materials collection site.



Mayor Lonelle Archuleta and Trustee Fil Archuleta have helped the community through the Outreach Center at the Town Hall for four years. So far in 2016, the Center has assisted 141 families with clothing, food and other items. The Outreach Center is open from 10:00 AM to Noon on Wednesdays.

If you'd like to help your neighbors in need, the Outreach Center needs blankets, canned soup and canned fruit. Donations can be made at the Outreach Center or the Town Hall.

## Garden City Gives Back

### You're making Garden City greener. We're helping.

Garden City residents and businesses received landscape vouchers and water rebates again in 2016. If you haven't taken advantage of these opportunities, watch the Spring Newsletter for information on how to apply for a voucher and water rebate in 2017.

Other ways the Board of Trustees is beautifying Garden City is through residential and commercial revitalization and fence grants. Projects covered by the revitalization grants include:

- Historic renovation
- Removal of false façade
- Chemical removal of paint from brick facades
- Stucco, new or restoration
- Painting (all colors must be approved)
- Window or door replacements or repairs
- Repointing of mortar joints for bricks or stone
- Repair Porches or Decks
- Landscaping
- Exterior doorways facing the street

## Mayor Pro-Tem of Garden City & Colorado Motorsports Hall of Fame Inductee

Garden City's own Clarence Krieger was inducted into the Colorado Motorsports Hall of Fame on Octboer 12, 2016.

Clarence Krieger began his racing career in the early 1950's, and competed in modified and late model divisions in Colorado and Wyoming for over 30 years of competition. He was always known as a "colorful character" and stout competitor who brought a strong sense of sportsmanship to the tracks at which he raced.

Clarence has lived in Garden City most of his life and has served on the Board of Trustees for decades, four years of which he was the Mayor of Garden City.
