#### Police Report

Sgt Dave Clarke from the Weld County Sheriff's Office addressed the Board regarding the March 2013 statistics. He reported that Lisa's Bar had been issued a show cause by State Liquor Enforcement. Whiskey River had an incident during March which required heavy response from several agencies but overall the situation has improved. Sgt Clarke would like to see better scanner management at Whiskey River later in the evening. Deputy Black reported that El Patron's has seen an increase in customers because a large Greeley bar closed down recently. The Deputy concurs that the management at El Patron's is weeding out the troublemakers each week.

#### Pat Hill – Street Repair and Maintenance 2013

Mr. Hill reported that he is working on the inlet drain design for 27<sup>th</sup> Street & 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue. He will work the flashing speed sign base into that design. The crack seal program has been delayed due to the weather. He will also address the pot hole in front of Archuletas' house when the weather clears.

She explained the recent increase in police calls due to a large bar closing in Greeley. She assured an increased effort by her and her staff to maintain orderly conduct in the establishment as they try to eliminate the troublemakers and has added extra security to help patrol the outside and parking lot. Lonelle Archuleta moved and Clarence Krieger seconded to approve the renewal of El Patron's Tavern with Live Entertainment Liquor License contingent on approval by the WCSO, Greeley Fire Dept and Weld County Health Dept. 7 Ave. 0 Nav. #### **Geophysical Survey Agreement with Mineral Resources and Geokinetics**

Logan Richardson from Mineral Resources and Bob Smith from Geokinetics were present to address the Board regarding the agreement and permit request from Mineral Resources and Geokinetics. The process of placing the data collection boxes will begin immediately. The heavy equipment that sends vibrations underground will take place on one day in the next week. The data collection boxes will remain in place for approximately two weeks. The agreement addresses any potential damage caused by the testing. The permit fee will be \$300.00.
