Police Chief’s Report

The November 2019 reports will be available at the first meeting in January 2020. Chief Black reported that there have been over 3,000 calls for service in 2019.

Attorney’s Report

Town Attorney Amy Penfold mentioned that there will be difficulties enforcing the Red Flag Law in 2020. The use of force by police officers, laws regarding vaping and nicotine, and Colorado’s Family Medical Leave Act are issues that will be coming up before the legislature but have not yet passed.

Town Administrator Abby Spaedt informed the Board that their nomination packets will be ready on January 2, 2020, although they may not be circulated until January 7, 2020.
