Minutes & Treasurer's Reports

B. Treasurer's Reports for July 2006

Vince Loftus moved and Nina Kendrick seconded to approve both the Minutes of Regular Meeting July 18, 2006 and the Treasurer's Reports for July 2006. 7 aye. 0 nay. Motion carried.

Weed and Inoperable Vehicle Ordinances

The Board reviewed the ordinances that Evans adopted to improve the weed, trash, and inoperable vehicle codes. Terry Greenwood was concerned about leaving the notices on the door. Since there were several other concerns about the code, Clarence Krieger moved to table the issue until next month. Terry Greenwood seconded. 7 aye. 0 nay. Motion carried.

Resolution in Opposition of Amendment 38

The Clerk read Resolution No. 2-2006, a resolution in opposition to the 2006 ballot issue known as "Petitions" Amendment 38 to the Colorado Constitution, that would make changes to the petitioning process and adversely impact operations of the Town of Garden City and to the detriment of the citizens of Garden City. Dennis Kendrick moved and Terry Greenwood seconded to adopt Resolution No. 2-2006. Roll call vote:

The Board reviewed a letter from UCED requesting someone to represent Garden City at a meeting in Fredrick on Wednesday August 16. There were no volunteers.

Budget Workshop

The Budget law states that the budget officer must submit proposed budget to the governing body by October 15th. Our October meeting is after that so the clerk needs to present a budget at the September meeting. Dennis Kendrick moved and Terry Greenwood seconded that the Board members call the clerk with requests or concerns for the budget instead of having a workshop. 7 aye. 0 nay. Motion carried.

NFRMPO

The Board reviewed some information from the NFRMPO. This was for information only, no action was required.

Other Board Issues

Dennis Kendrick asked why the street was being dug up on 8th Avenue. The clerk explained that the City of Greeley is realigning some of the water lines in preparation of some repairs.

When asked if we had heard anything about the street lights, the clerk replied that no one from Xcel has contacted us in any way about the bill for the 2001 street lights. We did receive a bill of \$144 for repair of the street light in front of 2743 6th Avenue Lane. That is an indication of vandalism so everyone needs to be aware of what people are doing to the street lights.

Clarence Krieger stated that there is still a lot of fighting and glass breakage in front of the house at 2712 6th Avenue Lane.

Residents Issues

Stoney Puente, 605 27th Street Road complained about the service we receive from the Police Department. The clerk offered to make an appointment for him to meet with the Police Chief.

Since there was no further business, Mayor Miller adjourned the meeting at 7:45 P.M.
