

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

The Special Meeting of the Town of Garden City was held on February 21, 1978 at 7:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Krieger. The minutes were read and approved.

The first item on the agenda was the 1% Sales Tax to be put on the ballot for vote in April. Mr. Parker read the Ordinance (copy attached to minutes) to the Board and discussed any questions regarding this item. The sales tax will be effective 7/1/78 and will be collected and sent by the merchants the same as they are sending sales tax now. We will only receive the check and not be involved in any of the collection of this tax. There is a stipulation that if there were to be a County wide tax the above 1% tax would no longer be collectable. There being no more questions Minnie Greenwood made the motion to adopt the Ordinance and Harold Folkers seconded the motion. The voting was as follows:

There being a majority of Yes' the ordinance was adopted by the Board and will be put on the ballot for the vote of the people and if carried by the majority the ordinance will be put into effect on July 1, 1978.

Steve Parker told us that he would no longer be our city attorney and he introduced Mr. Jeb McNew who will attend our meetings and continue to work with us on our legal matters along with Sam Telep.

Dick and Karen Loftus requested permission to construct a new body shop. They were told to get a building permit. The water is already at the building site and they were to check the zoning laws and discuss the building with any neighbors who might object. They will get the building permit and then the Board will vote on this matter. Harold Folkers made the motion that they be allowed to build this building, provided all requirements be met. Jim Mau seconded this motion and all voted yes.

Steve Parker will help us make up the ballots for our coming election. The only stipulation on running for an office is that the person must live in Garden City for 32 days.

Darrell Corgan Plumbing talked to Steve about the sewer line that the Wienerschnitzel will be using at their new building. It will have to run to 7th Avenue and there will be digging up of the street for $\frac{1}{2}$ block. It was decided that the Wienerschnitzel should be responsible for paying for this repair of the paving instead of Garden City, as it will be for their own use and not an addition to the City.

Mayor Krieger said the DA had called him regarding so many accidents in Garden City and the parking at Orville's Hanger. Jim Brown has this all under control and regarding the accidents, the Weld County Sheriff's office is to put on some extra men to patrol for awhile and see what is causing this problem

The city need some stop signs. One at 8th Avenue and 26th Street and the other by Nob Hill. Greeley is to take care of these signs.

Motion was made by Mary Folkers to pay the secretary and the miscellaneous bills. Minnie Greenwood seconded the motion.
