

Garden City Town Council  
 Regular Meeting  
 August 6, 1980

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Casey who announced that a quorum was present and that business could be conducted. Joe Cordova was absent.

The minutes of the June 3, 1980 meeting were read and approved on a motion made by Mary Folkers and seconded by Clarence Krieger. The vote was unanimous.

A motion to pay the bills was made by Vince Loftus and seconded by Clarence Krieger. The vote was unanimous.

The council received a copy of the proposed Weld County sales tax ordinance that will be placed on the ballot in the November election. The tax was discussed but no conclusions were reached.



It was seconded by Clarence Krieger and passed unanimously. The condition of the streets was also discussed. A motion to have all but 6th Avenue repaved was made by Harold Folkers and seconded by Clarence Krieger and passed unanimously.

An agreement was received from the Humane Society concerning fees for picking up stray dogs, etc. The agreement was signed and returned to the Humane Society.

Liquor licenses were renewed for the Library and Giliotti's on motions made by Clarence Krieger and seconded by Harold Folkers. Both motions passed unanimously.
