# FALL CLEAN-UP DAYS

## NOVEMBER 1 - 3

Time to get homes and yards cleaned up before winter sets in. Dumpsters will be located across from the Town Hall at 620 27th Street Rd.

This is a free service to residents and businesses in Garden City.

Please be sure to get all of your garbage into the dumpsters and keep the area clean.



Items that are **not allowed** in the dumpsters include:

- Toxic chemicals, paint, oil
- appliances containing freon (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc)
- batteries, concrete, dirt

You can help by calling the number on the side of the dumpsters if they're getting full
