There is a vacancy on the Board of Trustees. This is an exciting time to be a decision-maker for the future of our town. The Board has set goals for the next two years that will improve the quality of life for residents, businesses and visitors. Details are below, and the board goals are on the back page of the newsletter. Anyone who is interested and meets the requirements below is encouraged to apply.

To be appointed to a trustee position, you must be a resident of the Town of Garden City for at least the last twelve consecutive months, be at least eighteen years of age, and be a registered voter.

Board members are expected to attend two regular meetings, usually on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 P.M. In addition, there are occasional special meetings, which are normally of short duration. For each regular or special meeting attended, the Trustee pay is \$150.00, and dental and vision insurance is offered at no cost. AFLAC supplemental insurance is offered at the board member's expense.

The Town Hall does not have radio access to the Police Department and messages left on voice mail may not be received in a timely manner. 


Clarence Krieger April 22, 1938 - September 14, 2020

- You can register to vote and review your voter record to make sure your information is up to date online at https://www.sos.state.co.us/pubs/elections/main.html.
- October 9 Counties will begin mailing ballots.
- October 26 deadline to register to vote or update your registration and still receive a ballot in the mail.
- October 26 Last suggested day to return a ballot through the mail. After this date, voters should visit a drop box or vote center to drop off their ballot.
- In Colorado, you can register to vote and vote in person up to 7 PM on Election Day. Use the link in bold above to register online.
- We have registration form at the Town Hall, but we recommend registering online for immediate response.
