

Fall Clean - Up Days

We are handling Clean-Up Days differently this year. You MUST come to Town Hall to receive your coupons to be able to participate in the event. Your address will be VERIFIED by Driver License or a copy of your rental agreement/lease.

TWO COUPONS PER HOUSEHOLD

Dumpsters will be located across from the Town Hall at the Community Center: 620 27th Street Rd.

There will be an attendant at the front. You must show your coupon to be allowed in. If you do not have a coupon you will **not** be able to use the dumpsters.

Dumpsters will be available from 8AM-5PM Friday, Saturday and Sunday, November 3,4, and 5.

This is a free service to residents and businesses in Garden City.

DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS

- Toxic chemicals, paint, oil
- Electronics (tv, microwaves, etc)
- Appliances containing freon (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc), These items will NOT be accepted even if the freon component has been taken out.
- Batteries, concrete, dirt
- Tires, propane tanks, barrels


