Fall Clean - Up Days

We are handling Clean-Up Days differently this year. You **MUST** come to Town Hall to receive your coupons to be able to participate in the event. Your address will be **VERIFIED** by Driver License or a copy of your rental agreement/lease.

TWO COUPONS PER HOUSEHOLD

Dumpsters will be located across from the Town Hall at the Community Center:
620 27th Street Rd.

There will be an attendant at the front. You must show your coupon to be allowed in. If you do not have a coupon you will not be able to use the dumpsters.

Dumpsters will be available from 8AM-5PM
Friday, Saturday and Sunday, November 3, 4, and 5.

This is a free service to residents and businesses in Garden City.

DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS

- Toxic chemicals, paint, oil
- Electronics (tv, microwaves, etc)
- Appliances containing freon (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc), These items will NOT be accepted even if the freon component has been taken out.
- Batteries, concrete, dirt
- Tires, propane tanks, barrels

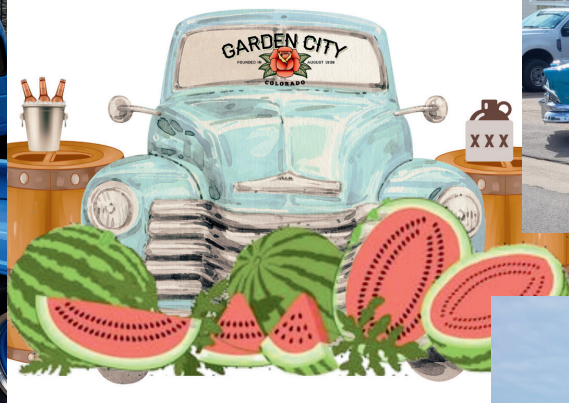
