These items are *not allowed* in the dumpsters:

- Toxic chemicals, paint, oil
- Appliances containing freon (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc.)
- Batteries, concrete, dirt

## Non-Emergency Call Information

If you require non-emergency assistance, please call Weld County Dispatch at 970-356-4015 Ext. 2700. Town Hall does not have the ability to dispatch the police. The most effective way to receive a police response is to call Dispatch at the number listed. As always, call 911 if you have an emergency.

All dogs must be licensed with the town! Dogs that are spayed and neutered are \$4 and dogs that are not, are \$10. All dogs must have proof of their rabies vaccination. Protect your pets if they ever get lost! If they have their tag, we know who to take them home to. Call Town Hall for more info on licensing your fluffy friends.

The fine for an unlicensed dog is \$25. If they are not licensed in our system, they will be taken to the Humane Society. Impound fees there start at \$130.
