SPRING CLEAN-UP DAYS

Time for Spring Cleaning! Dumpsters will (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc),

be located across from the Town Hall at the Community Center: 620 27th Street Rd. This is a free service to residents and businesses in Garden City.

Please be sure to get all of your garbage into the dumpsters and keep the area clean. Items that are *not allowed* in the dumpsters include:

- Toxic chemicals, paint, oil
- Appliances containing freon

(refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc), electronics (tv, microwaves, etc)

- batteries, concrete, dirt
- tires, propane tanks, barrels

The Town Hall does not have radio access to the Police Department and messages left on voice mail may not be received in a timely manner. Calling Dispatch is the fastest way to reach an Officer in a non-emergency situation. As always, in an emergency, dial 9-1-1.

NEW FACES IN GARDEN CITY


